Ash Trees and the Emerald Ash Borer

The Emerald Ash Borer (EAB) is a wood boring beetle native to northeast Asia. It was first detected in the U.S. and Canada in 2002 near the Detroit/Windsor area. Since then, the EAB has been detected in 35 states and the District of Columbia. North American ash trees are nearly defenseless against this beetle, so the death rate is nearly 100%. Speakers Bureau will discuss how the EAB kills ash trees, how to recognize ash trees and look for early signs of EAB infestation, and what options there are for treatment.
