Rain Garden Success: Tips for Installing and Maintaining Rain Gardens in Middle Tennessee

Andra will share her experience gained from managing the 2,900 square foot rain garden at Lane Agri-Park in Murfreesboro, TN, to help us better understand how to build a successful rain garden.
